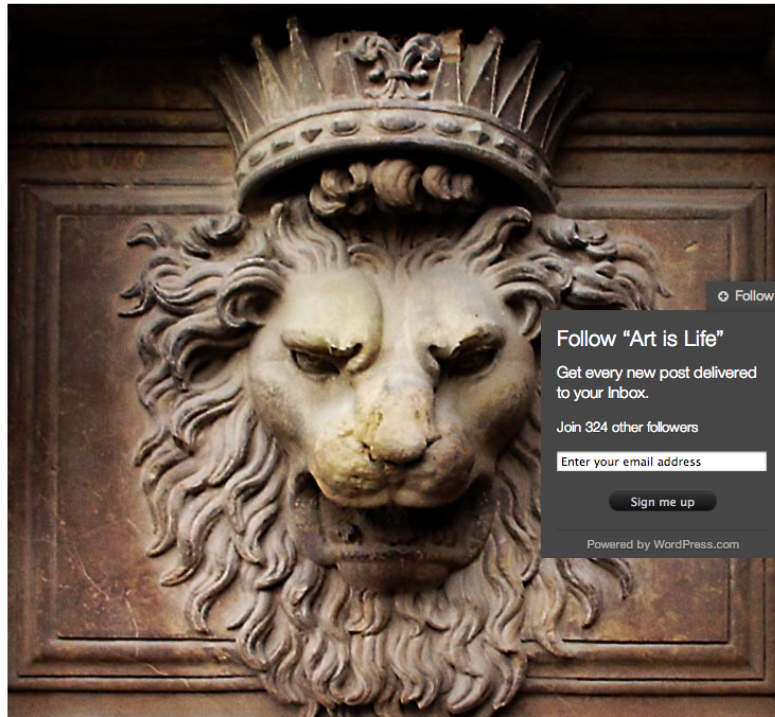

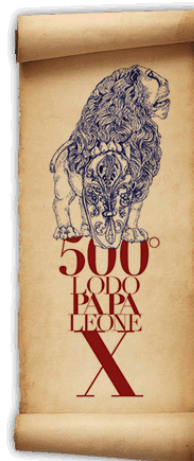

“Il Leone e i suoi simboli” – the Lion and his Symbols, is an international sculpture exhibition dedicated to the 500th anniversary of the Medici patronage of the Versilia area. It takes its name from the “Marzocco” or guardian lion figures, symbols of the Renaissance Florentine family’s power. The “Marzocco” is also the emblem of the celebration of the passage of the Versilia area from Lucca to Florence – many events are planned for this summer, and we hope to bring them to your attention as they happen.



Fourteen artists exhibit work in a show curated by Erica Cavalli and Lodovico Gierut; “the sculptors will examine both the international nature of the territory and their own personal takes on the historic passage, through the use of varied materials such as marble, bronze, terracotta, ceramics, wood and resin.” The artists are: Alberto Bongini, Giancarlo Cannas, Erica Cavalli, Massimo Facheris, Majd Patou Fathallah, Paolo Grigò, Renzo Maggi, Giorgio Mariani, Vaja Mikaberidze (aka Prasto), Mara Moschini, Szymon Oltarzewski, Alfredo Sasso, Marcello Scarselli, and Gabriele Vicari.
